COMMITTEE REPORTS

DCM - Megan M

Commemorative Big Books have been delivered and are available for pick-up from Megan. Area 51 Assembly was well attended by District 33 members. (see Assemble Summary attached below). Delegate's Report: GSO contributions up 5% over last year, birthday contributions are up 50% over the last five years, literature sales were up 2% over last year, expenses were slightly below budget, unfunded pension liability has been significantly reduced.

70th Southeastern Conference coming up in Charleston, WV August 14-17, 2014, 2014 SE Regional Conference will be in Puerto Rico September 26-28, and the 2015 International Convention will be held in Atlanta. "Many Paths to Spirituality" will be a new pamphlet offering from AA World Services.

Area 51 group growth is up 2% in the last year, 15% over the last 5 years, Membership growth is up 2 % over last year and 19% over the last 5 years. Area contributions to GSO up 9% over the last year, up 52% over the last 5 years. District 33 ranked within the top 3 in Area District contributors to GSO.

- Up to \$750.00 for the Budget and Finance Subcommittee to purchase a projector and viewing screen.
- To approve Amy M of Rocky Mount, NC as Area 51 Convention Chair for 2015-2016.
- To approve Craig P of Knightdale, NC as Area 51 Convention Alternate Chair.
